

# 2017 Lane County Fair Camping Rules

---



## CAMPING IS PERMITTED AT THE LANE COUNTY FAIR FOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS, VENDORS AND ENTERTAINERS ONLY

- 1) ALL Camping Permits will be sold and issued from the Fair Business Office.
- 2) **Spaces will be numbered and you must camp in your designated location. Campers parked in incorrect spaces may be towed. All utility/livestock trailers will be parked at a designated off-site location. FIRE LANES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES.**
- 3) Camping spaces range slightly in size (19'x30' in the West Area and 25'x30' in all other spaces) and location may depend on size of rig and Fire Marshall Requirements for spacing. There must be a minimum of 10 feet between each RV and between RVs and buildings. Electrical Usage may be limited at any time due to overages in camping areas.
- 4) **Purchased RV Camping includes 1 camping space and 1 weekly vehicle parking permit designated to the Pink Lot. NO CARS ARE ALLOWED IN CAMPING AREA.** Stock trailers will be parked at a designated off-site location. Additional weekly parking permits may be purchased through the Lane County Fair. These passes will provide you access to Posse monitored lots. Parking pass must be shown to avoid additional Posse parking fees and are on a first come, first serve basis. These spaces are not designated, you must park where spots are available.
- 5) Camping, and parking permits must be prominently displayed on the appropriate vehicle at all times. RVs and vehicles without permits are subject to towing.
- 6) Camper check-in will be Monday, July 17<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday, July 18<sup>th</sup>. Campers may not move out their RVs until after 8:00pm on Sunday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. Campers must be off the grounds by 4:00pm Monday July 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 7) Showers will be available during specified hours in the Ice Center. Hours will be posted and provided to Department Coordinators. Enter at the South end of the Ice Center.
- 8) All campground users must keep their space litter free and in a sanitary condition. NO DUMPING OR DRIPPING OF GRAY OR BLACK WATER. All units must be self-contained.
- 9) **Bikes, skateboards, in-line skates, scooters and ATV's are prohibited from the Fairgrounds during the Fair.**
- 10) **Alcohol, illegal substances, fireworks and lethal weapons are prohibited and will NOT be allowed in the camping areas. Those found with alcohol or illegal substances may be subject to loss of camping privileges, immediate expulsion from the fair and prohibition from future participation in the Lane County Fair.**
- 11) Glass containers cannot be taken out of camping units and brought into the general fairgrounds or barn area.
- 12) No person shall engage in fighting, use of obscene and abusive language, or conduct themselves in a disorderly manner while on the Fairgrounds. Rowdiness, profanity or vandalism will not be tolerated. Fair management reserves the right to dismiss any offender immediately for reasons satisfactory to itself, without refund. No excessive noise is allowed before 7:00am or after 11:00pm.
- 13) Red - A (West) gate will be manned 24 hours. This gate will be available for vehicles to enter the grounds at 6:30 am and vehicles must have appropriate passes to enter. All person(s) in the vehicle, including the driver, are required to have a fair pass to get through the gate. Vehicles must be operated safely and obey all traffic and parking regulations. Speed limit is 5mph. All vehicles must be off the grounds by 9:30 am. **ABSOLUTELY NO TRAFFIC ON GROUNDS BETWEEN 9:30AM AND 11:00PM THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE FAIR.** In case of an emergency, please contact a member of the Fair Staff.

**ANY VIOLATION OF THE CAMPER REGULATIONS MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF CAMPING PRIVILEGES,  
IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE FAIR AND PROHIBITION FROM FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN THE  
LANE COUNTY FAIR.**
