Important Dates and Deadlines

4-H/FFA Fair Rules

Eligibility

1. There is a \$20 entry fee per EXHIBITOR showing any project at the fair.
2. Youth aged 5-8 are eligible to participate in 4-H Cloverbud classes only. 4-H Cloverbuds may participate in a small animal Show N Tell, and all static exhibit categories. 4-H Cloverbuds may not exhibit Livestock, Dogs, or Horses.
3. Non-4-H youth ages 9-21 may participate in "Open Youth" livestock classes and should enter via the Lane County Fair directly.
4. Only Junior, Intermediate, and Senior age division exhibitors will be eligible for Reserve and Champion awards. Post Seniors will not be eligible for additional awards.
5. The project must be the work of the youth and completed within the current year. All fitting, daily care, and showing must be done by the youth exhibitor.
6. Exhibits and Animals may only be entered into EITHER open Fair class, 4-H classes, FFA classes, OR the open youth classes. Youth may choose to enter multiple exhibits and animals, but they must be DIFFERENT animals and DIFFERENT exhibits.
7. Classes for exhibits/contestants are based on the following age scale. An exhibitor's age is determined as of September 1st prior to the fair. For the 2018 fair, an exhibitor's age will be their age as of September 1st 2017.
 - a. Cloverbuds Ages 5-8 years old
 - b. Junior Ages 9-11 years old
 - c. Intermediate Ages 12-14 years old
 - d. Senior Ages 15-18 years old (or 19 if still in high school)
8. Ownership Date Requirements
 - a. All animals must be owned and managed by youth member no later than:
 - i. April 15th 2018
 - b. EXCEPTION: Poultry must be owned no later than:
